COACHING TIPS:---Quarterback Play By: Dick Yule

1. Always check the number of safeties as you approach the line of scrimmage. Are there one or two? This one piece of information is invaluable whether you are running or passing.
2. Seat the ball in your mid-section after taking the snap to avoid fumbles.
3. Your first step away from center (the separation step) is the most important. You must exaggerate this step during drills to achieve the maximum depth you need for the 3 & 5 step passing game.
4. Always carry out fakes and keep your head up. Every running play should be a fact-finding mission. The Q.B. can check bootleg possibilities, pass coverages and over committed safeties defending the run, all by keeping the Q.B.'s head up and carrying all fakes out.
